- » Create and perform specialized lift plans on an as needed basis

CARPENTERS

Training at a glance:

- » 4-year program
- » 5,840 hours on the job time
- » 400 hours related instruction time

Job duty examples:

- » Measure, cut, or shape wood, plastic, drywall and other materials
- » Install exterior finishes
- » Build and set forms for footings, walls, slabs, columns, and decks
- » Frame interior walls and install cabinets and stairs

OPERATING ENGINEERS

Training at a glance:

- » 3- to 4-year program
- » 6,000 hours on the job time
- » 400 hours related instruction time

Job duty examples:

- » Operate cranes, forklifts, Bobcats, backhoes, and skip hoists under general supervision
- » Control the speed and direction of the crane and hoist movement according to written, verbal, or signal instructions
- Understanding of working in precise limits and standards of accuracy
- » Lift, position, and place machinery, equipment, or other large loads on site

CEMENT FINISHERS

Training at a glance:

- » 3-year program
- » 3,600 hours on the job time
- » 400 hours related instruction time

Job duty examples:

- » Smooth and finish surface of poured concrete, such as floors, walks, and sidewalks
- » Set and align forms that hold concrete
- » Pour, spread, and level concrete using rakes, shovels, trowels, screeds, and floats
- » Form expansions, joints, and edges
